

Zero Waste Addingham Notes

ZOOM Meeting 13 July 2020

1. Welcome

Dave reported that the main agenda item was to agree the structure of the Table Top Trail Sale.

2. This meeting's minute taker.

Dave volunteered to take notes at the meeting.

3. Apologies noted above.

4. Table Top Trail Sale

Dave reported that he had been in contact with Wendy Green who said there were no other village events planned for Sunday 30 August 2020. The meeting agreed that the the Trail would be held on this day.

Sam outlined her thoughts for the event:

- 4.1 The objective is to raise awareness of waste and to use the table top sale as a vehicle for re-using unwanted items.
- 4.2 There will be a small charge of £5 for each householder who wishes to take part. This will be paid (preferably electronically) into the Civic Society bank account. For those who do not have internet banking a cheque will be accepted to be posted to Gill Battarbee.
- 4.3 The proceeds could be used e.g. to purchase one or more recycling bins for the village.
- 4.4. Sam will arrange for a registration form and a flyer to be drawn up ready for publication by 27 July 2020 together with a Facebook page. Dave agreed to send Sam a logo.

- 4.5 The following social media outlets may be used for publicising the event : AEG, Totally Locally, Addingham Community Chat, Addingham Quack Ilkley Chat.
- 4.6 Registration forms to be emailed to AEG@addingham.info no later than 23 August 2020.
- 4.7 Sam's husband Henry will produce a map of all stall holders in the village. Sam will contact Mark Preston to see if he is willing to distribute them from his shop.

Jan suggested that we should have a zero waste table - maybe situated outside the library. This was agreed.

5 Coffee pods

The coffee pod recycling has stalled owing to COVID-19. Children at school are not allowed to take anything other than personal possessions and packed lunches. Also the Memorial Hall has been closed.

The next available 'deposit date' will be the Table Top Trail on 30 August 2020.

Villagers should be encouraged to store their Coffee pods and bring them along to the stall outside the Library.
