1. **Apologies:** Jon Shaw

2. **Matters arising and actions from last meeting (5<sup>th</sup> September)**

The notes from the previous meeting were agreed.

3. **Refill pop-up (Jan)**

JH reported that the refill pop-up is going well so far, with some 25 customers for the first session and around 16 for the second session. A pop-up stall was also set-up in the Hub for the jumble trail.

The space in Mount Hermon has been booked until February '24.

4. **Jumble Trail 2023 debrief (Dave/Rick)**

DJ reported positive comments from the survey of stall holders, from which it is estimated around £2,000 was raised for the various charities. A surplus of £145 was also generated for the AEG.

It was noted that very few of the printed maps made available in advance in shops were taken, and this will be taken into consideration for the next jumble trail.

5. **Next Jumble Trail**

It was agreed that spring would be a better time of year to hold the event, so skipping 2024 the next will be in the spring of 2025.
